18th INTERNATIONAL SCULPTURE WORKSHOP
2024

An integral part of cultural life in the community of Nebelschütz not far from the large district towns of Bautzen, Bischofswerda, Hoyerswerda and Kamenz since 2006: the international sculpture workshop in the "Am Krabatstein" quarry near Miltitz. Regional, national and international artists work here every year for two weeks in late summer in the incomparable landscape - the "Am Krabatstein" quarry. Water, permaculture - gardens and wild nature characterize the gem of "Steinleicht e.V./Kamjenjak z.t."

Impressive sculptures made of granite, wood and metal have been created in 17 creative sculpture workshops to date.

For the summer of 2024, artists from home and abroad can apply to take part in the 18th International Sculpture Workshop at Krabatstein - Miltitz Quarry.

The two-week symposium will focus on the granite that occurs naturally at the site, but also oak wood and metal or combinations of the three materials. Artists are invited to apply to take part in the symposium with a meaningful idea sketch, the concept of which is to be implemented in these 14 days of sculpture workshop. The two-week symposium begins on August 19, 2024 and ends on September 1, 2024 with a finissage.

The materials granite (max. H = 1,200 mm x W = 1,200 mm x D = 600 mm, metal (no restrictions) and wood max. H = 2,000 mm, with approx. at least 700 mm trunk diameter) are provided. Dimensions required for the project idea, especially deviations for granite, should be requested.

Participants must bring any necessary tools with them. Upon request and if available, certain tools can be borrowed from the organizer **for a fee** and may also be purchased.

In order to avoid transport costs, the organizer gives priority to the artists arriving by plane to borrow machines and, under certain circumstances, tools at low cost.

The artist receives net donations of € 1,000.

The artist can spend the night on the quarry grounds in their own tent (a tent can also be rented on request), caravan or car; on request they can stay overnight in one of the very simple collective accommodations in the quarry (up to 6 people). Simple sanitary facilities and warm showers are available.

Your physical well-being is also taken care of with full board. Details will be announced and agreed upon when the contract documents are sent.

All sculptures created as part of the sculpture workshop are the property of the organizer; if sold, the artist receives 47.5% of the sales proceeds. 2.5% are statutory taxes. The remaining 50% will be used for the preparation and implementation of the upcoming sculpture symposia. The symposium and the resulting art objects will be documented and published in multimedia.

The application must necessarily include:

- **Meaningful outline of ideas for the implementation and completion of the main project during the symposium** (see contractual regulations if an invitation to the symposium is issued)
- Type and dimensions of the material
- an informal cover letter with all contact details (name, address, email, telephone)
- a CV in a table that clearly shows artistic qualities and commitment
- Documentation of recent works stating the title, the year of creation, the original dimensions and the materials used

The complete application must be received by email **by midnight on May 31, 2024.**
